






### GOD'S WORK

### Marriage Preparation

**Marriage Preparation:** To schedule a wedding, an engaged couple must meet with their parish priest or deacon at least eight months before their proposed wedding date. Preparation for the sacrament includes attending a diocesan program such as **Engaged Encounter** or **Pre Cana**. Also, couples of child-bearing age will need to take a full course of **Natural Family Planning**. Pre-registration for each of these programs is mandatory.

The next **Engaged Encounter** program will be **August 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>** at Marywood Retreat Center. The next **Pre Cana** program will be **August 18<sup>th</sup>** in Jacksonville. 
