RETIREMENT FUND for RELIGIOUS
December 5th– 6th

The national collection for the Retirement Fund for Religious will take place the weekend of **December 5th-6th**. Thank you for your support of this important Collection. Last year the Diocese of St Augustine contributed over \$138,129.82 **and our parish contributed \$6,933.41 to the fund.**



The annual Collection provides vital support for the day-to-day care of over 31,000 senior religious. For generations the care of elderly members has been carried out by religious who receive stipends. Today, however, the elderly religious far outnumber those who still earn a stipend. The total cost of care for senior religious has exceeded \$1 billion annually for the last three years.



Marriage Preparation: To schedule a wedding, an engaged couple must meet with their parish priest or deacon at least eight months before their proposed wedding date. Preparation for the sacrament includes attending a diocesan program such as **Engaged Encounter** or **Pre Cana**. Pre-registration for each of these programs is mandatory.


