Finally, if anyone knows of anyone (parishioner or non-parishioner) that is in need of assistance of any sort, please let me or one of the other officers know.

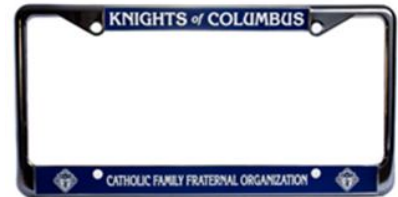
