We are still in need of a Life Program Director...pray on this and see if you are called to help in this endeavor.

Please mark your calendars for our next event - our **Parish Prayer Night on August 19th**. This event is being coordinated by our Family Program Director, Brian Cook. I ask for your support and participation. Look for more details at our next meeting and by email.

We are working through the details on our support of the new Aid and Support After Pregnancy (ASAP) program that Supreme has launched in support of the Hobbs decision overturning Roe v Wade. It is a practical way for us to help mothers and their families choose life. Our potential partner is Divine Mercy House and it appears that they meet all the requirements for our donations and outreach. We have a line item in the budget of \$2000 to donate, and Supreme will tack on another \$400 to that as well. More to come as we work through the partnership.

We had a successful Officer's Meeting on July 11th where we set the calendar for the fraternal year and worked up our budget, which we will share at the next meeting. Be assured that your time, talent, and treasure are being used well!
