Thank you to Brian Cook, our Family Program Director, for organizing our first Parish Prayer Night and Fellowship, and thank you to those brothers and their friends and family who attended in support. It was a fantastic start with over 60 attendees, where our Brother Deacon Rich Hay led us in Evening Prayers (also known as Vespers) along with an impressive presentation on its meanings and origins. Thank you also to Fr. Sebastian for his attendance, support, and illuminating words around the prayers.

Our next event is our Ministry Fair the weekend of Sep 24-25. Our Membership Director Noel David will be leading this effort and we will need your support before and after the Masses you attend to talk to candidates and potential Brothers. The simple question "Would you like to know more about the Knights?" is a great start. Get a phone number and get it to Noel and he will follow up. Raising Awareness About Life Insurance

Each September since 2003 has been designated as Life Insurance Awareness Month.
