PARISH MISSION

February 5-7. 2024

Our 2024 parish mission, presented by the Dominican Friars and Alumni of the Pontifical University of Saint Thomas Aquinas - Angelicum in Rome, Italy, will help our parish to see the Presence of God in our lives. This mission, in particular, will provide a unique grace for everyone who participates. In order to receive this special grace, there will be daily opportunities for each and every person in attendance to go to confession.

The Lord is at work, but we frequently fail to see or even notice Him. The first day's theme is Divine Providence, the second day is about the Divine Indwelling (how the Lord lives in the tabernacle of our souls) and the third day is about His Real Presence in the gift of the holy Eucharist and the healing power of Jesus to transform all of us.



GOSPEL REFLECTION

The truth that the visit of the magi declares, and the symbolism that their presence in the crib proclaims, is that Jesus is king for all nations of the earth. This is what we pray for in the words of the responsorial Psalm 72: the establishment of God's kingdom of justice and peace throughout the world so that the rights of the poor and helpless are respected and the cries of the needy are answered.

In the story of the revelation of Jesus to the magi, what is revealed to us about our own eagerness or reluctance to seek God? What is our own ability to listen to the Word of God, our own discernment of hypocrisy and hunger for power, in ourselves, our world, our church? What is our own attitude to strangers and our appreciation of their wisdom? Do we welcome refugees and asylum seekers in the parish or as neighbors, or do we regard them as a threat to jobs, property values, national security, our own comfortable and myopic spiritual wisdom? Where and when must there be both a "birth" and a "death" in our Christian lives as we gaze on Christmas Child?

♦In all three of today's readings we hear of different nations and different faiths coming together. How does your faith community reach out to those of different religions and different nationalities?






