# **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

Mark 16:15-20


The Ascension is one of the many-faceted Easter jewels that crown the liturgical year, and today's readings reflect this light. In the gospel reading from Mark, the risen Jesus has appeared to his followers during forty days—a biblical number symbolic of both fullness and transition—and instructed them about the promised coming of the Holy Spirit. So the disciples wait for this unimagined and unimaginable outpouring, while still hankering for knowledge of their own positions in this kingdom. Jesus deflects their desire for such answers into a concern for mission—the witness to him that the disciples will be called and empowered to give to the very ends of the earth.

The disciples are still a wounded community, wounded by Judas's treachery, by Peter's betrayal, and by their own cowardice. Yet it is in the midst of such failure, false expectations, and incorrigible personal ambitions and wishes for quick solutions, that Jesus will call them to mission. We too are sent to do new wonders, speak new words with the fire of the Spirit on our tongues, offer new healing to our sisters and brothers, and cast out contemporary "demons" from ourselves and others.

◆In the gospel we hear that Jesus, seated at the right hand of God, continues to "work with" the disciples as they preach and do good works. How do you experience Jesus's presence working with you in ministry?

# FROM THE BISHOP...

On Wednesday (May 1) the Florida Heartbeat Protection Act took effect. Babies' lives will be saved.

Contrary to what much of the media will say, this is not a law that ignores the good of women. The good of women includes their earliest moments in the womb.

This is a law that urges our whole society to support the great work of so many crisis pregnancy centers. We have many tireless volunteers who work hard for women and their babies. We must continue to support them as communities of faith.

Included in the media coverage of this Act is the reminder that there will be an abortion amendment on the November General Election ballot. Many have asked what our diocese is doing to defeat Amendment 4, and the early stages have been spent learning and planning. Our Office of Human Life and Dignity has been working with the Florida Conference of Catholic Bishops (FCCB) and other agencies in the state to unify efforts and clarify the message. Next week many people in our diocese will be attending a training session to work with our parishes. Following that training, we will have more concrete information and will be seeking the help of every Catholic to protect human life.

Please continue to examine the reality of Amendment 4 and help others learn. Language will be very important as you hear the many voices competing for your attention. Please look at the information already available by visiting https://www.flaccb.org/abortion-amendment

It is clear that much attention is being given to the question of abortion in Florida. Join in our efforts of prayer so that every life will be cherished, and our efforts will reflect the loving compassion of God.




