# REFLECTION

It is so easy to complain when things don't go our way. We don't understand why certain situations have to be so hard or why family members have to suffer. If anyone ever had anything to complain about it was certainly Job, but in today's first reading God called him out on it rather strongly.

God himself teaches us with this passage just how much he dislikes complaining. Our Psalm proclaims: "Give thanks to the Lord, his love is everlasting." And that sums it up right there. Period. We have the love of God, what more do we need? Thanks be to God!

Our second reading only confirms this thought. "The love of Christ impels us...whoever is in Christ is a new creation: the old things have passed away; behold, new things have come." Everything on this earth will pass away. Yet we should not fear, because we are a new creation in Christ and his love impels us forward.

In today's Gospel, the disciples fell into fear, and Jesus reminded them of his great power and love by calming the storm with just three words: "Quiet! Be Still!" When we call on him in faith, he can calm our storms as well. No matter how strong the winds or how tall the waves, Jesus can help us.

So whenever life's many trials and tribulations get you down, remember that complaining won't get you anywhere. Instead, lift your heart and mind to our all-powerful God and give thanks to him, whose love is everlasting.

# STATEMENT FROM BISHOP ERIK POHLMEIER REGARDING UNAPPROVED RELIGIOUS ORDERS AND FUNDRAISING EFFORTS

It has come to our attention that an article has been circulating about the establishment of a new Carmelite monastery in High Springs, Fla., led by Sister Loretta-Maria of the Blessed Trinity and the Rosary. This monastery is described as an autonomous entity, independent of any diocese, and not under the direct oversight or approval of the Vatican.

I wish to clarify that this new religious order and its associated activities are not approved by the Vatican or myself as the bishop of the Diocese of St. Augustine. The diocese recognizes and adheres to the guidelines set forth by the Holy See regarding the establishment and operation of religious communities. Any religious community or order operating within a diocese must be in full communion with and receive approval from the Vatican and the local bishop. Furthermore, the article states that Bishop Athanasius Schneider has given "his blessing" to Sister Loretta-Maria's efforts. Bishop Schneider is the auxiliary bishop of Astana in Kazakhstan and therefore, has no governing authority or jurisdiction in the Diocese of St. Augustine.

Additionally, it is important to address the fundraising efforts related to this new monastery. The faithful of the Diocese of St. Augustine should be aware that the High Springs Carmelite monastery has no relationship with the Discalced Carmelite Nuns who moved from Buffalo, N.Y., to Jacksonville in January 2024. The Jacksonville Carmelites, who are approved by the Vatican, are a legitimate monastic community under the vigilance of myself as bishop of the Diocese of St. Augustine.

We urge the faithful to support only those communities that are in full communion with the Church's legitimate authorities. The Jacksonville Carmelites of the Monastery of the Little Flower of Jesus have received proper approval and are in good standing with the diocese and the Vatican. 
